## RESTARTING CROQUET UNDER CA GUIDELINES AND GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS

### Clubhouse

- Only one person allowed in at a time.
- Entry limited to accessing mallets, hand washing and toilet.
- Use paper towels provided or bring your own towel.
- No refreshments (coffee/tea making/biscuits/cakes) to be prepared or consumed in the Clubhouse. Bring any food or drink you might need.
- Clean or sanitise any surfaces you have used.
- Take away your own rubbish, including used paper towels.

### Facilities

- Hoops to be set out each morning by B & C Jamieson and must be left all day. They will then be removed by B & C after last booking each day.
- Gate by Clubhouse will be open, not padlocked, during the day. Use this gate ONLY.
- Clubhouse should be locked, but not padlocked, during the day when no-one is playing.
- Plastic chairs and sunshade should not be used.
- Please leave the Clubhouse locked top and bottom when finished.

### Court priorities

- Lawn open 8.30am to 9.00pm daily.
- Two half-courts to be set on Tuesday and Friday.
  - Tuesday am: T&F Group have priority for GC until 12Noon.
  - Tuesday pm: Any member for GC or AC.
  - Friday am: Any member for GC.
  - Friday pm: T&F Group have priority for GC 2.00- 4.00pm.
- Full court on the five other days for AC or GC.

### Reservations

- Play available only to members who have booked on TeamUp in advance; two hours maximum.
- Singles, doubles or double-banked play (AC or GC) permitted on full court; i.e a maximum of four players on the full court at a time.
- Double-banked games must be of the same discipline and have the same start time.
- Only two players allowed on each half-court.
- Bookings must be made by 6.00pm the previous day.

### Biosecurity

- Members needing a club mallet should sign for it in the Clubhouse, take it home and use it as a personal mallet until these restrictions are over.
- Gloves recommended.
- Do not handle hoops and, as far as possible, balls.
- Wash balls and AC clips with soapy water from water butt and leave them between the Clubhouse and equipment shed for the next players.
- Two metre separation to be observed.
- Wash hands or use your own sanitizer!
